

Immunization Requirements

California law requires parents to submit a documented immunization record prior to school admission. All immunizations must be up-to-date and no student will be admitted to school without documentation on file. The chart below lists the requirements.

3-4 Year Old Kindergarten

POLIO	3 doses are required
DTP	4 doses are required
MMR	1 dose given on or after the 1st birthday
HEPATITIS B	3 doses
HIB	1 dose given on or after the 1st birthday
VARICELLA	1 dose or doctor's verification that the child has had chickenpox with the month and year of disease listed

5 Year Old Kindergarten & Grades 1 - 12

POLIO	4 doses at any age, but 3 doses meet requirements for ages 4 and up if at least 1 dose was given on or after the 4th birthday
DTP	5 doses at any age, but 4 doses meet requirements for ages 4 and up if at least 1 dose was given on or after the 4th birthday
MMR	2 doses both on or after the 1st birthday
HEPATITIS B	3 doses

VARICELLA

1 dose or doctor's verification that the child has had chickenpox, with the month and year of disease listed; Out-of-state entrants 13 years old or older must have a 2nd dose of Varicella 4 weeks to 3 months after the 1st dose

Tdap

New California law requires students entering grades 7-12 to show proof of having 1 dose on or after the 7th birthday; This is NOT required for 5 year olds.

A TUBERCULOSIS SKIN TEST IS NOT REQUIRED FOR ANY AGE.
